



Surveyed for Walter Dun, John Graham and Gross Scruggs, 1300-1/3 acres of land on part of Six Military Warrants, Dun 666-2/3 acres on No. 5802, 166-2/3 acres on No. 5800, 200 acres on No. 6126, 100 acres on No. 6119, Graham 24 acres on No. 5791 and Scruggs 143 acres on No. 5916 on Oak run a branch of Deer creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak and Hickory, Westerly corner to Francis Ratliff's Survey No. 4511 and North-erly corner to Ann Garnett's Survey No. 8005; thence with her line S. 20 W. 227 poles crossing a branch at 84 poles to a Stake in a prairie, West-erly corner to Garnett's said Survey, in the line of Stuart and Arbuckle's Survey No. 5673; thence with their line West 74 poles to a Black Walnut and White Oak, Northwesterly corner to their Survey and corner to Elias Rector's Survey No. 4518; thence with Rector's line N. 40 W. 40 poles to a Bur Oak, Northeasterly corner to Rector's said Survey; thence with another of his lines West 120 poles to an Elm and Bur Oak, Northwesterly corner to said Rector's Survey in the line of the Representatives of Peter Helphenstine's Survey No. 4387 of 800 acres; thence with their line North 55 poles to five Bur Oaks and a large Elm, Northeast corner to Helphenstine's Said Survey; thence with another line of said Survey West 50 poles to a Stake in said line; thence N. 14 W. 375 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 63 E. 214 poles to a Hickory on the edge of a prairie; thence N. 15 E. 60 poles to a White Oak and Hickory; thence N. 43 W. 129 poles crossing a branch to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 60 W. 100 poles to two White Oaks; thence N. 20 E. 140 poles crossing Oak run at 12 and the road from Chillicothe to London at 54 poles passing five White Oaks, Easterly corner to Joseph Hoffman's Survey No. 5531 of 157 acres at 114 poles to two Elms, Southwesterly corner to Elias Rector's Survey No. 5648 & 6322; thence with Rector's line S. 70 E. 435 poles to a Stake in a small boggy prairie in said line, Northwesterly corner to Jesse McKay's Survey No. 6323; thence with McKay's line S. 20 W. 138 poles to a Black Oak, Southwesterly corner to said Survey; thence with another of McKay's lines S. 70 E. 62 poles to two White Oaks and a Black Oak, Southeasterly corner to McKay and Northwesterly corner to Ratliff's said Survey; thence with Ratliff's upper line S. 20 W. 180 poles crossing the run at 90 poles and the road to the beginning.
