
Surveyed for Walter Dun, Gross Scruggs, assees. and Joseph Gregory, heir to Napthaline Gregory, decd. 740 acres of land on part of eleven Military Warrants, Dun 169 acres on No. 6126, 33 acres on No. 5547, 29 acres on No. 5862, 80 acres on No. 6093, 3 acres on No. 6086, 25 acres on No. 6125, 10 acres on No. 6089, 62 acres on No. 6098, 73 acres on No. 5718, Scruggs 246 acres on No. 5916 and Gregory 10 acres on No. 5905, on Barren run a branch of Treacle's creek. Beginning at a White Oak and Bur Oak, Northwesterly corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7482; thence with his upper line S. 6 W. 79 poles crossing barren run in a Wet prairie to three Bur Oaks, the most Westerly corner to the said Survey; thence S. 52 W. 40 poles to a White Oak; thence S. 70 W. 28 poles to two White Oaks; thence N. 55 W.

50 poles crossing a branch at 30 poles to a White Oak; thence N. 70 W. 45 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 60 W. 68 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root in a prairie; thence N. 40 W. 74 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence S. 70 W. 120 poles to five Bur Oaks from one root, on the edge of a prairie; thence N. 35 W. 78 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 30 E. 60 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 9 E. 164 poles to four Bur Oaks; thence N. 45 E. 132 poles to a Stake in a prairie and two Bur Oaks on the edge of the prairie, bearing S. 21 W. 3 poles 16 links distant, Southwesterly corner to Walter Dun's Survey No. 8414; thence with his South line correcting the course S. 89° 23' E. 211 poles crossing a branch of the Lake fork of Little Darby in a wet prairie to a Stake in the line of Dun's said Survey; thence S. 30 W. 49 poles to a Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie; thence South 143 poles to a Bur Oak, White Oak and Hickory; thence S. 19 E. 146 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 59 E. 46 poles to the beginning.
