



Beginning at a Honey Locust and three Elms on the North bank of a large branch, South-erly corner to Hoff and Taylor's Survey No. 3726; thence with their upper line N. 42 W. 200 poles to a White Oak and Black Oak, West corner to said Survey; thence S. 48 W. 160 poles to three Black Oaks and two White Oaks, in the lower line of Joseph Swearingen's Survey No. 4200; thence with said line S. 42 E. 200 poles crossing the branch at 146 poles to a White Oak and Hickory, Easterly corner to said Survey; thence N. 48 E. 160 poles crossing the branch to the beginning.

Beginning at two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, Southeast corner to John Crawford's Survey No. 7075; thence binding thereon N. 12 W. 148 poles to two Black Oaks and a Bur Oak; thence West 96 poles to an Ash, Elm and Bur Oak; thence North 52 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence East 40 poles to a Lynn, Elm and Hickory; thence North 22 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 55 E. 72 poles to two Elms and forked Bur Oak, corner to Graham's and Johnson's Survey No. 8540; thence binding on said Survey N. 76 W. 93 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence North 87 poles to a Bur Oak; thence West 80 poles to two Hickories; thence South 24 poles to a Hickory; thence West 98 poles to two White Oaks, in the line of Haine's Survey No. 7791; thence S. 10 E. bind on said Survey 622 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of Galloway's Survey No. 5744; thence binding thereon East 50 poles to a Stake; thence S. 75 E. 200 poles to an Elm and Bur Oak, Northwest corner to Mathew's Survey No. 5749; thence East 165 poles to an Elm, Black Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence N. 2 E. 217 poles to a stake in the line of Crawford's said Survey; thence binding thereon West 57 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence North 26 poles to a Hickory and Bur Oak; thence N. 46 W. 41 poles to a White Oak; thence North 30 poles to a Bur Oak, Red Oak and Hickory; thence West 125 poles to the beginning.
