

Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 800 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, 300 acres on No. 6523 and 500 acres on No. 6522, on the waters of the Spring fork of Treacle's creek.

Beginning at a forked Bur Oak and Black Oak, Westerly corner to John Crawford's Survey No. 6201; thence with his line, N. 40 E. 52 poles to three White Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 50 E. 30 poles to a White Oak, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, N. 58 E. 94 poles crossing a branch to a Black Oak and two Hickories, Northerly corner to said Survey and corner to the Representatives of George McCormicks Entry No. 12129; thence with the line of said Entry N. 60 W. 188 poles to a White Oak, Bur Oak, Hickory and large Black Oak, Southerly corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7528; thence with his line N. 34 W. 65 poles to three Bur Oaks, Westerly corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 26 E. 146 poles to five Bur Oaks, three of them from one root, corner to said Survey; thence East 96 poles to a Bur Oak, Northerly corner to said Survey; thence N. 12 E. 40 poles to a Hickory White Oak and Black Oak, Southerly corner to Dun and others Survey No. 7924, 8441 & 8442; thence with their line N. 40° 30' W. 83 poles to a forked Bur Oak, corner to said Survey; thence with another of their lines S. 70 W. 206 poles to a Stake, Southwesterly corner to said Survey; thence with another of their lines N. 15 E. 124 poles to a Stake, corner to said Survey, in the line of James Galloway's Survey No. 7402; thence with his line N. 75 W 66 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory, corner to his Survey; thence with another of his lines, S. 15 W. 24 poles to three Bur Oaks, two of them from one root, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 75 W. 96 poles to three White Oaks, corner to said Survey and Easterly corner to Levi Springer's Survey No. 9138; thence with Springer's line S. 48 W. 265 poles to a Stake and two Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey in the line of said Galloway's Survey No. 7403; thence with said line East 121 poles to two Bur Oaks, Northeast corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines South 116 poles to three Bur Oaks in said line, Northwest corner to said Galloway's Entry No. 1209; thence with the line of said Entry S. 70 E. 234 poles to a Bur Oak and Stake, Easterly corner to said Entry, in the line of Nathaniel Sawyer's Entry No. 10608; thence S. 50 E. 196 poles to the beginning,
