

Mickle's Survey No. 9825 & 10626, in the line of the Representatives of Nicholas Hobson's Survey No. 6350; thence with Hobson's line N. 10 E. 30 poles to a White Oak and Black Oak, the Black Oak down, corner to said Survey; thence with another of their lines N. 18 W. 98 poles to a Stake in the line of the Representatives of David Drummon's Survey No. 5478; thence with said line S. 40 W. 162 poles to a Stake in said line, corner to Mickle's said Survey; thence with his line East 130 poles to the beginning.



Beginning at two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, Southerly corner to Bradford's Survey No. 4208 and Southeast corner to No. 3971; thence N. 65 E. 82 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, in the line of No. 6482; thence S. 2 E. 165 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 87 E. 104 poles to a small Jack Oak, corner to No. 9440; thence S. 29 E. 67 poles to two Hickories; thence S. 8 E. No. 12119 93 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 35 W. 104 poles to three Pin Oaks in 184 acres. the line of Hill's Survey No. 8876; thence N. 25 W. 401 poles to the beginning.

Binning at two Bur Oaks Southeast corner to Carter's Survey No. 5874 and c cornerto No. 8417 & 8696; thence with the lines of No. 8417, N. 88-3/4 E. 111 poles to a Bur Oak; thence North 155 poles to a Hickory and Jack Oak; thence East 41 poles to two Bur Oaks, corner to No. 8507; thence S. 11 W. 77 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 39 E. 102 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 88 E. 74 poles to a Stake in the line of No. 6969; thence S. 55 W. 66 poles to a Stake; thence S. 38 E. 48 poles to two White Oaks, Black Oak and Hickory in the line of No. 2681; thence S. 33 W. 215 poles to two Bur Oaks, corner to No. 8696; thence N. 16 W. 187 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 48 W. 36 poles to the beginning.
