

Surveyed for the Representatives of George McCarmick

250 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6381 on the waters of the Spring fork of Treacle's Creek.

Beginning at three Bur Oaks from one root in the edge of a prairie; Southeast corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7528; thence N. 28 E. 84 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 59 W. 89 poles to a Bur Oak corner to Graham; thence N. 11 E. 55 poles to a Hickory,

White Oak and Black Oak; thence S. 87 E. 101 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 34 E. 62 poles to two

Bur Oaks; thence N. $42\frac{1}{2}$ E. 134 poles to a White Oak and Black Oak;

thence N. 62 E. 62 poles to three forked White Oaks, corner to Dun & Graham's Survey of 480 acres; thence S. 67 E. 32 poles to two Bur Oaks, corner to Nicholson's Survey No. 5578, and corner to Case No. 5482; thence with Case's line S. 5 W. 98 poles to a Hickory and Bur Oak corner to Walter Dun's Survey No. 8443; thence with his line S. 81 W. 103 poles to two White Oaks a Hickory and Black Oak; thence S. 20 W. 49 poles to a Bur Oak and White Oak; thence S. 15 E. 46 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence S. 40 E. 34 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 78 E. 62 poles to a Bur Oak in the line of William Case's Survey No. 5481; thence with his line S. 9 E. 34 poles to a Stake; thence S. $71\frac{1}{2}$ W. 273 poles to the beginning.

Creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak, Southwest corner to Daniel Brown's Survey No. 7303; thence West 77 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 38 E. 88 poles to two Bur Oaks, Southeast corner to Snead's Survey No. 3405;

thence N. 25 W. 162 poles to a White Oak, Black Oak and Hickory; thence N. 65 E. 212 poles to a Stake,

Southeast corner to Hill's Survey No. 8876; thence

N. 25 W. 229 poles to three Pin Oaks; thence N. 35 E.

123 poles to two Post Oaks; thence N. 71 E. 20 poles

to a Stake in the line of No. 6483 & 6945; thence

S. 20 E. 60 poles to a White Oak; thence S. 70 E. 52

poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 62 E. 52 poles to two

Bur Oaks; thence S. 83 E. 34 poles to a Post Oak; thence

N. 75 E. 22 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 38 E. 31 poles

to three Post Oaks; thence S. 60 E. 20 poles to a Post Oak;

thence South 149 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 89 W. 10 poles to three

poles to a large White Oak corner to Brown; thence W. 160 poles to
