

Beginning at a White Oak and Hickory Southwesterly corner to Beverly Stubblefield Survey No. 6317; thence N. 14 E. 112 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak, Northwesterly corner to said Survey; thence N. 37 W. 24 poles to two White Oaks and a Bur Oak, Southwesterly corner to Gross Scrugg's Survey No. 7828; thence with his line N. 22 W. 115 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 51 E. 83 poles to a barren Oak; thence N. 52½ E. 151 poles to two Bur Oaks corner to said Survey; thence S. 84 E. 127 poles to five Hickories corner to said Survey and Southwesterly corner to Dun and Graham's Survey No. 9199, 9358, 9380 & 9497; thence with their line N. 28 E. 84 poles to a Hickory and two Bur Oaks corner to said Survey; thence N. 20 E. 60 poles to a forked Black Oak, their corner; thence ---34 E. 65 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 40 W. 141 poles to two Bur Oaks corner to said Survey; thence N. 38 W. 58 poles to three White Oaks, Northwesterly corner to said Survey and corner to James Johnson's Survey No. 7833; thence with his line S. 47 W. 99 poles to a large Bur Oak his corner; thence S. 54 W. 60 poles to a Bur Oak; thence with another of his lines S. 27 W. 129 poles to two Bur Oaks his corner; thence S. 47 W. 106 poles to two Hickories and a forked Bur Oak; thence with another of his lines N. 74 W. 159 poles crossing a glade at 86 poles to two Bur Oaks, Southwesterly corner to said Survey and corner to James Galloway's Entry No. 10619; thence with his line S. 53 W. 52 poles to three Hickories from one root, corner to Galloway; thence S. 37 E. 88 poles to two Bur Oaks, Easterly corner to Edward Watt's Survey or Entry No. 9839; thence with Watt's line S. 53 W. 123 poles crossing a glade twice to three Hickories, corner to said Watt's in the line of Robert Mean's Survey No. 5195; thence with said line S. 37 E. 330 poles crossing a Glade to two White Oaks in said line; thence S. 67 E. 50 poles to the beginning.
