


Surveyed for the Representatives of George McCarmick 255 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6381 on the waters of Treacle's Creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, Northwest corner to Nathaniel Fox's Survey No. 8479; thence N. 11 W. 85 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 24 E. 70 poles to a Bur Oak in the line of Gross Scrugg's Survey No. 7876; thence S. 60 E. 46 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 70 E. 24 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 11 E. 86 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 70 E. 24 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence N. 87 E. 115 poles to three Hickories, a White Oak and four Bur Oaks two of them from one root; thence S. 40 E. 55 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 58 W. 100 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory, in the line of John Hackley's Survey No. 10585; thence S. 57 E. 131 poles to three Hickories; thence S. 85 E. 117 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 425 acres of land on part of three Military Warrants, 135 acres on No. 6520, 60 acres on No. 6523 and 230 acres on No. 6522, on the waters of the Spring fork of Treacle's Creek. Beginning at a White Oak, Easterly corner to John Crawford's Survey No. 6201; thence with his line



S. 41 W. 140 poles, crossing a branch at 10 poles to a Hickory, Southerly corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, N. 50 W. 90 poles to two White Oaks in said line; thence S. 40 W. 144 poles to a Hickory and Bur Oak; thence S. 80 W. 248 poles to two Bur Oaks, Northerly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 7404; thence with his line S. 53 E. 206 poles to two White Oaks, one of them forked, corner to said Survey; thence N. 62 E. 16 poles to two Elms corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 15 E. 62 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, S. 75 E. 13 poles to a Stake in said line, corner to James Johnston's Survey No. 7833; thence with said line N. 15 E. 94 poles to a Stake corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 75 E. 62 poles to two Bur Oaks and a White Oak corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, N. 57 E. 172 poles to a Bur Oak, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 44 E. 116 poles crossing a branch at 104 poles to a large Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie, Northerly corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 49 E. 56 poles to two Hickories, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 36 E. 66 poles to a White Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 62 E. 202 poles to a Black Oak, Easterly corner to said Survey; most Northerly corner to said Galloway's Survey No. 6030, in the line of Robert Mean's Survey No. 5281; thence with Mean's line N. 46 W. 47 poles to a White Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, N. 10 E. 218 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 75 W. 120 poles to three White Oaks, Westerly corner to said Survey; thence S. 61 W. 178 poles to the beginning.
