



Surveyed for Thomas Lucas 250 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6547 on the Waters of Little Darby's Creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks from one root, Northwest corner to D. Chapman's Survey No. 10987 and 12170 and corner to James Johnson's Survey No. 8586 & 8698; thence with Chapman's lines, S. 10 E. 103 poles to a Stake; thence S. 42 E. 60 poles to a Stake; thence S. 1 W. 126 poles to a Stake; thence S. 89 E. 83 poles to a Stake; thence S. 79 W. 181 poles to a Stake, corner to Allen Latham's Survey No. 10764; thence N. 2 E. 145 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 30 W. 89 poles to five Bur Oaks from one root, corner to Graham's Survey No. 7393; thence with Graham's lines N. 24 W. 75 poles to a Bur Oak and Jack Oak; thence N. 88 E. 77½ poles to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 1 E. 92 poles to three Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey No. 8586 & 8698; thence with the lines of said Survey, N. 26° 40' E. 132 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence S. 14 E. 152 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root; thence S. 30 W. 56 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for Thomas Lucas 90 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6547, between Little and Big Darby. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, corner to Jessup N. Couch's Survey No. 8265 and corner to George Galloway's Survey No. 7059; thence N. 6 E. 54 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 89 W. 32 poles to a Stake; thence S. 84 W. 214 poles to an Elm, corner to John Graham's No. 7392; thence with his line S. 17 E. 73 poles to two White Oaks corner to Galloway; thence N. 9 E. 48 poles to an Elm; thence S. 18 E. 78 poles to a Bur Oak; thence South 30 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 60 E. 24 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 76 E. 32 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 23 E. 70 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 88 E. 62 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Peter P. Mayo, assee. 254 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6537 on the waters of the Little Miami. Beginning at a Bur Oak at the Southerly extremity of Ludlow's line North corner to John Campbell's Survey No. 9023, and West corner to Thomas Pemberton's Survey No. 10773; thence with Pemberton's line East 144 poles to a Stake in a prairie corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines North 247 poles to a Post Oak, Black Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence West 90 poles to a Stake; Northeast corner to the Representatives of William Sanford's Entry No. 12078; thence with said Entry South 50 poles to a Stake, Southeast corner to said Entry; thence with another line thereof West 125 poles to a Stake corner to said Entry in Ludlow's line; thence with said line S. 20 E. 208 poles to the beginning.
