


Surveyed for Joseph and Benjamin W. Ladd and Thomas Norvell, assees. 730 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5880, on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at two Black Oaks, Northeast corner to George Mathew's Survey No. 5706, running with his line South 30 poles to a Bur Oak, Northwesterly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 7069; thence with his line East 176 poles to a Bur Oak Red Oak and Hickory, corner to his Survey; thence North 20 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence East 32 poles to a forked Hickory; thence N. 23 E. 40 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 80 E. 28 poles to three Hickories corner to said Galloway's, Southwesterly corner to Robert Mean's Survey No. 5982; thence with Mean's line N. 24 W. 210 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to his Survey; thence with another of his lines East 188 poles to a three forked Black Oak, corner to his Survey; thence North 40 poles to a Stake in the line of a Survey made for John Edwards No. 3828; thence with the line of said Survey, West 106 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie, Southwest corner to said Survey; thence North 400 poles to a Stake in the line of the Representatives of Richard Call's Survey No. 7162; thence with the line of said Survey, West 178 poles to a Stake, Southwest corner to said Survey; thence South 76 poles to a Stake in the line of Archibald Finley's Survey No. 4890; thence with his line East 32 poles to two Bur Oaks, northeast corner to his Survey; thence South 160 poles to three Hickories, Southeast corner to his Survey; thence West 52 poles to a Bur Oak, corner to George Balloway's Survey No. 7060; thence South 36 poles to two Elms and an Ash; thence S. 65 W. 64 poles to a White Oak; thence N. 67 W. 14 poles to two Black Oaks and a Hickory; thence S. 20 W. 88 poles to three Hickories corner to said George Galloway's Survey; thence East 66 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory, Northeasterly corner to Cadwallader Wallace' Survey No. 8829; thence with his line S. 25 E. 164 poles to a Stake corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 53 W. 140 poles to a Stake, Southerly corner to said Wallace; thence S. 20 E. 54 poles to two Hickories and a White Oak in said Mathew's line; thence with his line East 4 poles to the beginning.

Daniel Brown's Survey No. 7303; thence East 133 poles to two White Oaks in the line of Francis Ratliff's Survey No. 4685; thence North 180 poles, crossing a branch at 40 poles to three White Oaks in said line; thence West 133 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory; thence South 180 poles, passing the Northeast corner of Brown's said Survey at 30 poles to the beginning.
