




West 178 poles to a Black Oak, Northwest corner to his Survey No. 9285 & 10626 in the line of Walter Dun's Survey No. 8785; thence with said line N. 48 1/2 E. 116 poles to a Stake corner to said Dun's Survey and Southerly corner to the Representatives of David Drummon's Survey No. 5478; thence with his line N. 40 E. 32 poles to a Stake in said line; thence East 130 poles to a Stake in the line of Hobson's Survey; thence with his line S. 10 W. 80 poles to three White Oaks corner to their Survey; thence with another of their lines N. 65 W. 50 poles to two Hickories and a Black Oak corner to their Survey; thence with another of their lines South 45 poles to the beginning.

Stake in a prairie, Easterly corner to his Survey and Westerly corner to William White's Survey No. 3642; thence with White's line S. 35 E. 134 poles to a Stake; thence S. 55 W. 300 poles to a Stake in the line of the Representatives of John Robin's Survey No. 4888; thence with the line of said Survey N. 35 W. 134 poles to the beginning.
