


Surveyed for Robert Porterfield and Cadwallader Wallace, assees. 160 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, Porterfield 120 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres on No. 57 and Wallace 40 acres on No. 6217, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at four White Oaks, the most Westerly corner to George Baylor's Survey No. 464 and Easterly corner to Ann Garnett's Survey No. 7883; thence with her line S. 20 E. 193 poles to a Stake in a prairie, East corner to her Survey; thence with another of her lines S. 65 W. 143 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of Charles Scott's Survey No. 6482; thence with his line N. 88 E. 188 poles to a Stake in a prairie, in said line; thence S. 30 E. 20 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the Easterly line of said Survey; thence with said line S. 10 W. 162 poles to four Bur Oaks, Southeasterly corner to said Survey; thence with another line of said Survey S. 86 W. 53 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 20 E. 99 poles to a Stake in a prairie, the most westerly corner of said Scott's Survey No. 6483; and 6945; thence with his line N. 75 E. 99 poles to three Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 52 E. 54 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 50 E. 560 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for Cadwallader Wallace, assee. 68 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6217 on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at a Hickory, Southeasterly corner to William Creighton's Survey No. 5670 and corner to Jesse McKay's Survey No. 6224; thence with McKay's line S. 35 E. 193 poles to two Elms, his South corner and North corner to Dun Graham and Scrugg's Survey No. 8846; thence with their line S. 20 W. 26 poles to five White Oaks, East corner to Joseph Harness' Survey No. 8863; thence with his line N. 51 W. 105 poles to a White Oak, Hickory and Elm, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 54 W. 76 poles to two White Oaks and two Hickories, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 22 W. 24 poles to a Stake South corner to Creighton's said Survey; thence with his line N. 20 E. 150 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Daniel Brown, assee. 45 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5474, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at four Bur Oaks and an Elm, Southwest corner to his Survey No. 6101, in the line of Elihu Scott's Survey No. 6268; thence with said line West 51-3/4 poles to five White Oaks and a Hickory, Northwest corner to said Survey; thence North 140 poles to a Stake, Southwest corner to Cornelius Baldwin's Survey No. 6062; thence with his line East 51-3/4 poles to a Stake in said line, northwest corner to Brown's said Survey; thence with Brown's line South 140 poles to the beginning.
