



Surveyed for Strother Settle and John Branham 1240-2/3 acres of land, Settle 840-2/3 acres on part of a Military Warrant No. 2858 and Braham 400 acres on No. 3089 on Paint Creek and the waters of Deer Creek and the Little Miami. Beginning at a Black Oak and two Hickories, Southwest corner to Peter Pelham's Survey No. 6384, and Southeasterly corner to John Emmett's Survey No. 6385; thence with Pelham's line East 43 poles to three Bur Oaks, Northwest corner to John A. Fulton's Survey No. 8223; thence with his line South 172 poles crossing Paint Creek to a Stake in a prairie, Southwest corner to said Survey; thence East 297 poles crossing a branch of Paint Creek and Walnut run to a Stake in a prairie in a line of Alexander Kerr's Entry No. 9278; thence with said Entry and William Champ's Entry No. 9039, South 233 poles to a Stake, Southwesterly corner to Champ's said Entry; thence East 127 poles crossing the run to a Stake in the line of the Representatives of Peter Helphenstine's Survey No. 4514; thence with their line S. 19 W. 140 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak, Westerly corner to their Survey; thence South 24 poles to a Bur Oak in their line; thence West 43 poles crossing the run at 6 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of Jacob Lewis' Survey No. 7183; thence with his line N. 10 E. 34 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Northeasterly corner to said Survey; thence N. 80 W. 100 poles to a Hickory and Post Oak, his Northwesterly corner; thence S. 10 W. 50 poles to a Stake in his line; thence West 38 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence North 10 poles to two White Oaks; thence West 210 poles crossing the branch at 30 and Paint creek at 192 poles to a Hickory and Post Oak; thence North 260 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence West 373 poles crossing a branch to a Stake in Ludlow's line; thence with said line N. 20 W. 126 poles to a Stake therein, the most Southerly corner to William Robinson's Survey No. 8606; thence with Robinson's line N. 50 E. 294 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of Emmitt's said Survey; thence with Emmitt's line South 56 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Southwesterly corner to said Survey; thence East 40 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Survey; thence North 39½ poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Survey; thence East 120 poles crossing the branch to the beginning.
