

Beginning at two Bur Oaks, Northeast corner to John McDonald's Survey No. 6064, in the line of the Representatives of Peter Helphenstine's Survey No. 4387; thence with McDonald's line South 125 poles to three Hickories, two from one root; thence East 140 poles to a Stake in the line of Survey No. 5795; thence with said line N. 12 W. 128 poles to two White Oaks, Northeasterly corner to said Survey in the line of Helphenstine's Survey; thence with said line West 116 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for William Creighton, Jun. 40 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5026 on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at two White Oaks and a Hickory, Northeast corner to George Hoffman's Survey No. 6910, in the line of Joseph Harness' Survey No. 5532; thence with Hoffman's line South 60 poles to a Stake in said line, Northeast <sup>WEST</sup> corner to William McKee's Survey No. 9782; thence with his line East 115 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Northeast corner to said Survey in the line of said McKee's Survey No. 5898; thence with said line N. 18 W. 188 poles to a Hickory and Black Oak, Northwest corner to said Survey and corner to Harness' said Survey; thence South 121 poles to a Bur Oak, Southeasterly corner to said Survey; thence West 76 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Walter Dun and Benjamin Goodin, assees. 686-2/3 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, Dun 400 acres on No. 3614 and Goodin 286-2/3 acres on No. 231 on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a Black Oak, Northeasterly corner to John Campbell's Survey No. 8342; thence with his line S. 1 W. 236 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, Southeast corner to said Survey and Northwest corner to Josiah Newman's Survey No. 1341; thence with Newman's line N. 88° 20' E. 200 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Northeast corner to said Survey and Southwest corner to Miles Jennings' Survey No. 540; thence with Jennings' line and the line of John Redwood's Survey No. 540 and Zachariah Jones Survey No. 540 and John Bowman's Survey No. 540, North 397 poles to a Stake in a prairie in said Bowman's line and in the line of Charles A. Stuart's Survey No. 6457; thence with Stuart's line West 389 poles passing his Southwest corner and with the line of the Representatives of Richard Call's Survey No. 7162, to a Stake in said line; thence South 197 poles to a Hickory and Black Oak, Northwest corner to Campbell's said Survey; thence with his line N. 81° 50' E. 160 poles to the beginning.
