


Surveyed for David Kirkpatrick 140 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6624, between the Big and Little Darby and in Fulton's trace. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, Northwest corner to Allen Latham's Survey No. 10764 and in the line of John Graham's Survey No. 7393; thence binding on Graham S. 58 W. 118 poles to three Black Oaks, two from one root; thence N. 57½ W. 40 poles to four Bur Oaks; thence N. 57 W. 40 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, corner to No. 7916; thence S. 8° 20' W. 132 poles to a Bur Oak,

Northeast corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7392; thence with his line South 102 poles to an Elm in a prairie, his corner; thence N. 84 E. 200 poles to a Stake in a prairie, a Southwesterly corner to Jessup N. Couch's Survey No. 8265; thence with his lines and binding on his Survey, N. 17 E. 15 poles to four Bur Oaks two from one root; thence S. 69 E. 70 poles to four Bur Oaks; thence S. 76 E. 56 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 29 E. 62 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence N. 87 E. 128 poles to three Bur Oaks in the line of James Johnson's Survey No. 7239; thence with his line N. 23 E. 52 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to Walter Dun's Survey No. 11012; thence N. 58 W. 87 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Southwest corner to Dun and corner to David Chapman's Survey No. 10987 & 12170; thence South 50 poles to two Bur Oaks, Southeast corner to Chapman's; thence S. 71½ W. 175 poles to a Stake near a Bur Oak, Southeast corner to Latham's Survey No. 10764; thence with his line N. 89 W. 253 poles to four Bur Oaks; thence N. 15 E. 153 poles to a forked Bur Oak; thence N. 89 E. 116 poles to an Elm; thence N. 24½ E. 30 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 14 E. 43 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Cadwallader Wallace, assee. 350 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 2377 on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at a Black Oak and Hickory in the line of John Shearer's Survey No. 5526, Northeast corner to Cornelius Baldwin's Survey No. 6062; thence North 62 poles to two Hickories, Northwest corner to Shearer's said Survey in the line of John A. Fulton's Survey No. 8122; thence West 15 poles to a "hite Oak, Black Oak and Hickory, Southwest corner to said Survey; thence with another line thereof North 226 poles crossing a branch at

85 poles to a Stake in a pond in the line of Elias Langham's Entry No. 7662; thence West 320 poles, passing the Southeast corner of John McDonald's Survey No. 6064 and with his line passing his Southwest corner and with the line of Langham's and Hobson's Survey No. 7291 to three Bur Oaks, Southwest corner to their Survey; thence with another line thereof North 104 poles to a Black Oak and "hite Oak, Southeast corner to Mathew Hobson's Survey No. 10520; thence with a line thereof West 160 poles to a Stake, Southwest corner to said Survey in the line of said Fulton's Survey No. 8121; thence with said line, South 39 poles to a Stake corner to said Survey; thence with another line thereof, East 90 poles to a Stake, corner to said Survey; thence with another line thereof S. 13 E. 98 poles to a Bur Oak corner to said Survey and Northwest corner to William Robinson's Survey No. 6051; thence with his line East 197 poles to four Hickories, Northeast corner
