


Surveyed for John Evans, Assee. 33-1/3 acres of land on part of

 No. 12880. No. 6648 on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at two Hickories  
 120 acres. and a Bur Oak, Southwesterly corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7386  
 and Easterly corner to Walter Dun's Survey No. 7752; thence S. 27 W. 34  
 poles to a Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie, Southeasterly corner to said Survey No. 7752  
 thence South 84 poles to a Stake in the North line of Graham and Johnson's Survey No.  
 8540; thence with said line East 117 poles to a large Bur Oak a Northerly corner to their  
 said Survey, in the line of the Representatives of James Winkfield's Survey No. 4573;  
 thence North 27 poles to a Stake, Northwest corner to Winkfield's said Survey; thence  
 East 43 poles to a forked Bur Oak, Southwest corner to Rice Haggard's Survey No. 7057;  
 thence North 58 poles to a Stake, Northwest corner to Haggard's said Survey; thence East  
 48 poles to a Stake, Southerly corner to John Moore's Survey No. 6508; thence with Moore's

 30 acres. Oaks, Northeast corner to said Dun's Survey No. 7753 and corner to said Dun's  
 Survey No. 8636; thence with the line of said Survey No. 8636, N. 50 E. 64  
 poles to two Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey in the line of Ladd and Norville's  
 Survey No. 8999; thence with said line S. 2 E. 122 poles to a Stake in the line of  
 John Graham's Survey No. 7929; thence with Graham's line S. 59 W. 106 poles to two Bur  
 Oaks, corner to said Survey in the line of Dun's said Survey No. 7753; thence with Dun's  
 said line N. 34 E. 32 poles to five Bur Oaks from two roots, corner to said Survey; thence  
 with another line thereof N. 14 E. 104 poles to the beginning.
