


Surveyed for Mathew Bonner, assee. 180 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6650 on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at a Stake and two Post Oaks, Southeast corner to John A. Fulton's Survey

No. 8223, in the line of Suttle & Branham's Survey No. 9821; thence with said line East 107 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the west line of Alexander Kerr's Survey No. 9278; thence with said line North 103 poles to two Hickories, one fallen down, Northwest corner to said Survey; thence with his North line, East 222 poles to three Bur Oaks, Northeast corner to said Survey, in the line of Charles Cutt's Survey No. 9185; thence with his line N. 12 E. 65 poles to a Stake in a prairie, two poles South of the line of Peter Pelham's Survey No. 6384; thence East 103 poles to a Stake, 2 poles S. 45 W. from three hickories, corner to Pelham's said Survey; thence South 115 poles to a Stake, 2 poles S. 45 W. from a Bur Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence S. 75 E. 90 poles to two hickories, Northeasterly corner to Cutt's said Survey; thence North 20 poles to a Stake in the line of Pelham's said Survey; thence with said line West 83 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence North 116 poles to three Hickories, corner to said Survey; thence with another line of said Survey, West 450 poles to two Bur Oaks, Northeast corner to Fulton's said Survey; thence with his line South 175 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Joseph Spencer 380 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6568 on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at two Pin Oaks and two Hickories, each marked X in the South line of Joseph Harness's Survey No. 5533, 5797, 5798 & 8212 near the East



edge of a large prairie and 145 poles West from the Southeast corner of said Harness' Survey, running S. 3 W. 19 poles to two Pin Oaks and a Hickory; thence S. 21 W. 90 poles to three forked Bur Oaks; thence S. 72 W. 41 poles to six Bur Oaks; thence S. 61 W. 32 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 51 W. 46 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root,

one of them forked; thence South 30 poles to a Stake in the line of William Creighton's Survey No. 7260; thence with his line and course thereof West 160 poles to a Stake; thence North 50 poles to three Bur Oaks, two of them from one root; thence West 126 poles crossing a branch to two Hickories, Northeast corner to Zachariah Jones' Survey No. 540 and Southeast corner to John Bowman's Survey No. 540; thence with said Bowman's line passing his corner and with the line of Joshua Stephenson's Survey No. 540, North 139 poles to a Stake in a prairie, in said Stephenson's line, and in the line of said Harness' Survey; thence with said Harness' line East 419 poles, crossing two branches to the beginning.
