




Beginning at a White Oak corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7832 and Walter Dun's Survey No. 8589; thence with the line of Dun's said Survey S. 20 E. 21 poles to a Stake in the line of James Galloway's Survey No. 7062; thence with the line of said Survey East 72 poles to a Stake, corner to said Survey; thence with another line thereof S. 12 E. 52 poles to a Bur Oak, Blue Ash and Hackberry, on the bank of Darby's Creek, corner to said Survey; thence up the creek with the meanders thereof North 27 poles, thence N. 16 E. 25 poles to a Stake; thence West 74 poles to a Stake in the line of Lucas Sullivant's Survey No. 9530 thence with said line N. 37 W. 38 poles to a Stake in the line of Graham's said Survey No. 7832; thence with said line S. 6 W. 10 poles to the beginning.

Pendleton's Survey No. 7418; thence with a line of said Survey N. 66 E. 11¼ poles to two White Oaks, corner to Duncan McArthur's Survey No. 7683; thence with McArthur's line N. 6 E. 103 poles to the beginning.
