


Surveyed for Thomas Bell 666-2/3 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 305 on the Northwest of the Ohio, and on Deer creek a branch of the Scioto. Beginning at three White Oaks on the point of a ridge, Southerly corner to George Baylor's Survey No. 464, running South 334 poles to three White Oaks; thence East 320 poles crossing Deer creek at 114 poles to two Elms and two Black Oaks; thence North 334 poles, crossing a branch at 256 poles to two Black Oaks and a White Oak in said Baylor's line; thence with said line West 320 poles crossing the creek at 200 poles to

the beginning .

Surveyed for George Baylor 2922 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 2317 and part of No. 101 on the Northwest of the Ohio, and on Deer creek a branch of the Scioto. Beginning at four White Oaks, Southerly corner to Thomas Bell's Survey No. 462, running S. 20 E. 830 poles to three White Oaks on the point of a ridge; thence East 534 poles crossing Deer creek at 120 poles to a Stake; thence N. 20 W. 1040 poles to a Stake, Easterly corner to said Bell; thence with his line S. 69 W. 500 poles to the beginning.
