



Surveyed for Beverly Stubblefield 334 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 1203 on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at a Stake in a Prairie, Northeast corner to Ann Garnetts Survey No. 8751; thence East 258 poles to a Stake in the line of Uriah Springer's Survey No. 1020; thence with said line N. 70 W. 402 poles passing his West corner and with the line of Tunstall Quarles Survey No. 4086 to two Bur Oaks in said Quarle's line, Northeast corner to William Creighton's Jr. Survey No. 7262; thence with his line S. 20 W. 106 poles to three Bur Oaks, Southeast corner to said Survey; thence N. 86 W. 477 poles to two bur oaks and a Hickory, Southwest corner to said Survey; thence North 135 poles crossing Walnut run to a Stake in a Prairie, Northeast corner to said Survey, in the line of said Garnett's Survey No. 8005; thence with said line N. 86 W. 39 poles to a Stake in a Prairie corner to said Survey, Northeast corner to James Harris' Survey No. 4590; thence with his lines South 92 poles crossing the run to a Stake in a Prairie, Southeast corner to said Survey; thence West 27 poles to a Stake in a Prairie, Southwest corner to said Survey in the line of Stewart and Arbuckle's Survey No. 5673; thence with said line S. 98 poles, passing their Southeast corner and with the line of James Armstrong's Survey No. 6526, to two Hickories from one root, Southeast corner to said Survey; northeast corner to the heirs of Nicholas Hobson's Survey No. 8749 and Northwest corner to Elias Bancroft's Survey No. 6456; thence with his line East 135 poles to a Post Oak, Northeast corner to said Survey and Northwest corner to Benjamin Stubblefield's Survey No. 5205; thence with his line S. 88 E. 224 poles to a bur oak; Northeast corner to said Surveys and Northwest corner to Garnett's Survey No. 8751; thence with her line East 343 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Beverly Stubblefield, 210 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 1203 on the waters of the South fork of Darby's Creek. Beginning at two bur oaks one of them forked, 74 poles N. 29 W. from the Northeast corner of James Fowler's Survey No. 4731, running N. 61 E. 116 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 47 E. 238 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 61 W. 190 poles to a Stake in the line of said Fowler's Survey; thence with his line N. 29 W. 227 poles to the beginning.
