



Beginning at four Elms, lower corner to Thomas Holt's Entry No. 4934, running down the creek with the meanders thereof, S. 10 W. 44, West 22nd, S. 45 W. 20, S. 45 E. 24, S. 45 W. 46, South 70, S. 45 E. 24 S. 5 W. 44, S. 25 W. 12 poles to two Black Walnuts one forked; thence N. 78 W. 150 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 12 E. 225 poles to a Stake in a Prairie; thence S. 88 E. 150 poles, passing the lower back corner of said Holt's Entry and with the lower line of the same to the

beginning.

Beginning at two Black Walnuts one of them forked, lower corner to said Gardner's Survey No. 4938, running down the creek with the meanders thereof S. 25 W. 29, S. 75 W. 45, S. 10 W. 24, S. 70 W. 25, S. 15 W. 18, S. 4 W. 106, S. 27 E. 30, S. 3 E. 21 poles to a small Elm; thence N. 70 W. 170 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 20 E. 230 poles to a White Oak; thence S. 78 E. 160 poles passing the lower back

corner of said Gardner's Survey, and with his lower line to the beginning.
