


Surveyed for Robert Means, assee, 300 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5231 on the South fork of Darby's creek. Beginning at a willow

easterly corner to John Askew's Survey No. 4748 and Southerly corner to Thompson, Patton and Hackley's Survey No. 4199; thence with their line, the line of James McNutt's Survey No. 4749, of Strothers Jones' Survey No. 4750 and Daniel Morris' Survey No. 2584, N. 55 E. 480 poles crossing the said fork several times to two White Oaks and a Honey Locust, Easterly corner to Morris' said Survey in the line of Richard C. Anderson's Survey No. 4942; thence S. 35 E. 100 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 55 W. 480 poles crossing a branch in a prairie to a Stake; thence N. 35 W. 100 poles to the beginning.




Surveyed for Elias Rector, assee. 356-2/3 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, 340-2/3 acres on No. 1653 and 16 acres on No. 4851 on the waters of Oak Run,

a branch of Deer creek. Beginning at two Elms, one forked, Southeast corner to Joseph Harness' Entry No. 5531, running S. 70 E. 440 poles to three White Oaks in the line of Sigismond Stribling's Entry; thence N. 20 E. 130 poles to a White Oak and Black Oak; thence N. 70 W. 440 poles to two Black Oaks and a Hickory; thence S. 20 W. 130 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for William Creighton, Jun. assee, 300 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5138 on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at a Hickory and Hickory Stump, North corner to James L. Markham's Survey No.

No. 5670. 8003 and Southwesterly corner to Jesse McKay's Survey No. 6324; thence N. 20 W. 153 poles to a Stake corner to said Markham in the line of Joseph Harness's Survey No. 8863; thence with said line N. 22 W. 66 poles to a Stake corner to said Survey; thence with another of Harness' lines N. 36 W. 300 poles passing his Northeast corner at 115 poles to a Stake in the line of Robert Sharp's Survey No.

5897; thence with said line N. 46 E. 100 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory Easterly corner to said Survey; thence S. 60 E. 270 poles to a Black Oak and two Hickories, Northwesterly corner to Sigismond Stribling's Survey No. 5802, and North corner to McKay's Survey; thence S. 19 E. 35 poles to a Bur Oak, corner to said McKay; thence West 62 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root, corner to said McKay; thence South 61 poles to the Beginning.
