


Surveyed for William Arbuckle and Charles S. Stewart, assee, 150 acres of land on a Military Warrant and a part of another, viz: Arbuckle 100 acres on No. 5346 and Stewart 50 acres on part of No. 4878 on Walnut run a branch of Deer creek. Beginning at a stake, Northeast corner to Elias Rector's Survey No. 4518, running East 120 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence South 200 poles to three Bur Oaks, two from one root, crossing Walnut run at 170 poles; thence West 120 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence North 200 poles crossing the run and passing the Southeast corner of said Rector's Survey at 35 poles near the run, to the beginning.



Surveyed for Robert Means, assee, 1166-2/3 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5387 on Opposum run, a Northeasterly branch of Deer Creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a Black Oak the Black Oak marked D. Mc. about N. 77 E. and about 777 poles from the Southeasterly corner of Baron Stuben's Survey No. 2698; running N. 24 W. 450 poles to a White Oak; thence N. 52 W. 274 poles to a stake in a line run for Richard Apperson's Entry No. 5433; thence with said line, North 136 poles to five Elms and an Ash, on the bank of Opposum run; thence S. 74 E. 211 poles crossing the run at 186 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 20 E. 70 poles to a Bur Oak, Elm and Red Oak; thence S. 70 E. 230 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 20 E. 450 poles, crossing a branch to a White Oak; thence S. 42 1/2 W. 297 poles crossing the run to the beginning.

Surveyed for Joseph Spencer, 30 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6567 on the waters of the Little Miami. Beginning at three Hickories, most Westerly corner to Galloway and Russell's Survey No. 6597 and corner to Samuel Lapsley's Survey No. 8227; thence with Galloway & Russell's line S. 10 E. 66 poles to a Bur Oak and Elm, corner to said Survey; thence with another line of said Survey, S. 75 E. 103 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey in the line of Wm. White's Survey No. 3642; thence with said White's line, S. 87 W. 165 poles to a stake in a prairie, N.W. corner to White's said survey and corner to said Lapsley's Said survey; thence with said Lapsley's line N. 27 1/2 E. 114 poles to the beginning.
