



Surveyed for Sigismund Stribling, 1666-2/3 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 996, on the Waters of Deer creek. Beginning at an Elm, Northwest corner to Nathan Littler's entry No. 5801, running S. 20 W. 356 poles to a Black Oak, Hickory and White Oak, Southwest corner to said Littler's entry; thence S. 70 E. 300 poles to three White Oaks, Southeast corner to said Littler's Entry; thence S. 45 E. 307 poles to a stake; thence S. 20 W. 300 poles to a Stake in the line of Charles Buck's Entry No. 4540; thence with his line and the line of Francis Ratliff's Entry No. 4511, N. 70 W. 200 poles to a Black Oak; thence N. 20 E. 278 poles to a White Oak and Black Oak; thence N. 70 W. 440 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory; thence N. 20 E. 80 poles to two Elms; thence N. 70 W. 140 poles to two Hickories and a Black Oak; thence N. 19 W. 390 poles to a Hickory and Bur Oak; thence N. 60 E. 60 poles to three Hickories and a Black Oak; thence East 200 poles to two Hickories; thence S. 70 E. 220 poles to the beginning.

Beginning at two Hickories and a White Oak, 82 poles North of the Spring used by Thomas Springer and near his cabin lately burnt; thence West 100 poles to a Bur Oak, Elm and Hickory; thence North 160 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence East 100 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence South 160 poles to the beginning.
