


Surveyed for the Representatives of William Carter, decd. 354 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5173, on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at two Elms, one of them forked, and a Bur Oak, Northeast corner to John Crawford's Survey No. 7075, running with his line South 215 poles crossing a branch to a Bur Oak, Southeast corner to his Survey; thence East 54 poles to a Bur Oak, Hickory and Elm; thence South 48 poles to a White Oak; thence S. 66 E. 40 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence South 26 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence East 176 poles to two Bur Oaks and an Elm; thence North 144 poles crossing a branch to three Bur Oaks; thence West 86 poles to two Bur Oaks, an Elm and Black Oak; thence North 164 poles, crossing a branch to two Bur Oaks; thence West 182 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for Jesse McKay and Joseph and Benjamin W. Ladd, assees. 300 acres of land on two Military Warrants McKay 200 acres on part of No. 5340 and Ladd's 100 acres on No. 6039 on Bradford's fork of Deer creek, a branch of Deer creek. Beginning at a White Oak



and Black Oak, West corner to Elias Langham's Survey No. 4777; thence with the upper line of said Survey, N. 45 E. 123 poles crossing the fork to a Hickory and White Oak, North corner to said Langham's Survey and corner to Benjamin W. Ladd's Survey No. 6432; thence with a line of Ladd's said Survey, S. 76 W. 270 poles crossing the fork at 250 poles to two White Oaks and a Black Oak; thence S. 55 W. 30 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence South 66 poles to four White Oaks; thence S. 14 E. 47 poles crossing a branch at 42 poles to a large Bur Oak; thence S. 78½ E. 382 poles to two White Oaks, South corner to said Langham's Survey; thence with his line, N. 45 W. 260 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Jesse McKay, assee. 250 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5340 on the waters of Bradford's fork of Deer creek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, running S. 52 W. 120 poles to a double Bur Oak, crossing the North branch of said fork at 60 poles, 100 poles below where Langham's road to the waters of Mad river crosses the same, the first time going up; thence N. 80 W. 100 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 17 W. 160 poles to a Post Oak; thence S. 70 W. 60 poles to a White Oak and Hickory; thence N. 17 W. 118 poles to a Black Oak and Post Oak; thence N. 73 E. 110 poles to three Post Oaks; thence S. 30 E. 60 poles to a dead Bur Oak and two Post Oaks; thence S. 47 E. 257 poles to the beginning.
