


Surveyed for James Currie, assignee, 1000 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 1852, on the northwest of the Ohio, and on Deercreek, a branch of the Scioto. Beginning at three white oaks southwest corner to Thomas Bells Survey No. 874, running South 500 poles crossing a branch at 126, one at 173 and one at 496 poles to three white oaks and an elm; thence East 320 poles, crossing Deercreek at 148 poles at the upper part of an Island to a hickory and two black oaks; thence north 500 poles to two elms and two black oaks, southeast corner to Bell; thence with Bell's line, West 320 poles, crossing the creek at 206 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for Samuel K. Bradford, 1000 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 350, on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at three white oaks, northwest corner to William Washington's Survey No. 1284, and northeast corner to Patrick Carnes Survey No. 1256, running with Washington's line East 400 poles to two ash's and an elm, northeast corner to Washington; thence North 400 poles crossing a large branch at 200 poles to two elms, a post white oak and ash; thence West 400 poles crossing a branch at 144 poles to a cherry, two post white oaks and an elm; thence South 400 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Churchill Jones 1000 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 2311, on the northwest of the Ohio and on Deer Creek, a branch of the Scioto. Beginning at three elms, easterly corner to Baron Steubens Survey No. 2698, running S. 69 W. 320 poles, crossing Deercreek at 160 poles to three small ash's on a trace, southerly corner to Steubens; thence S. 21 E. 500 poles to a white oak; thence N. 69 E. 320 poles crossing the creek at 120 poles to a hickory, ash and elm thence N. 21 W. 500 poles to the beginning.
