


Surveyed for Samuel Baskerville, 333-1/3 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 5481, on the waters of Deer creek; Beginning at three White Oaks, Southeast corner to John Shearer's Entry No. 5226, 80 poles South from an Elm marked I.S.X.O. on the waters of Cypress run, running with Shearer's line North 120 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence East 100 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence South 320 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence West 40 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence South 90 poles to a Black Oak; thence West 116 poles to three Post Oaks; thence North 290 poles to a Black Oak, White Oak and Hickory; thence East 56 poles to the beginning.




Surveyed for James Galloway, Jr. assee. 525 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, 380 acres on No. 5355, and 145 acres on No. 5516 on Deer creek. Beginning at two White Oaks and an Elm, Southwesterly

corner to Stephen Southall's Survey No. 553, running with said line, N. 64 E. 500 poles, crossing the creek at 176 and a branch at 405 poles, to a Black Walnut and Honey Locust in the line of said Southall's Survey and Northwesterly corner to Robert Means' Survey No. 5046; thence with his line S. 26 E. 168 poles crossing a branch at 150 poles to two Elms and a forked Hickory in said Means' line; thence S. 64 W. 500 poles crossing the creek at 326 poles to two Ashes and a Hickory; thence N. 26 W. 168 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for James Galloway, jur. assee, 50 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5355, on the waters of the Spring fork of Treacles' creek. Beginning at a Stake on the North side of a small branch, where the line of Robert Means' Survey crosses it, running with his line N. 46 W. 40 poles to a Black Oak; thence N. 82 W. 134 poles crossing a branch at 98 poles to two bur oaks; thence S. 10 E. 60 poles to three White Oaks; thence S. 88 E. 176 poles to two Hickories and a White Oak; thence N. 10 W. 20 poles, crossing the branch to the beginning.
