



Beginning at two Black Oaks Southeast corner to Samuel Smith's Survey No. 4156; thence with a line thereof S. 70 W. 70 poles to ten White Oaks, Northeast corner to John Hay's Survey No. 6058 and 6059; thence with his line, S. 23 E. 220 poles to three Post Oaks, Southeast corner to said Survey; thence N. 52 E. 86 poles to a Hickory, corner to Lucas Sullivant's Survey No. 7657; thence with his line East 87 poles to four Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence N. 30 E. 61 poles to a Black Oak, North corner to said Survey; thence S. 24 E. 111 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Survey; thence North 370 poles to a Stake in the line of Wallace and Dunlap's Survey No. 6391, 7894, 9652 & 9697; thence with said line N. 37 W. 181 poles to two Post Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence S. 52 W. 211 poles to a Stake in the line of Smith's said Survey; thence with said line S. 20 E. 36 poles to two White Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence S. 70 W. 40 poles to an Elm and Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence S. 20 E. 110 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for William Robinson, assee. 1000 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 5298 and 254 acres on part of No. 5402, on the waters of the East fork of Paint Creek. Beginning at four Post Oaks, Southeast corner to Mathew Bonner's Survey No. 10797; thence with his line North 165 poles to a Stake in the line of said Robinson's Survey No. 7899; thence East 460 poles to a Black Oak and a Bur Oak; thence South 321 poles to three Bur Oaks on the west side of the United States road, in the line of Samuel Smith's Survey No. 4156; thence with said line S. 70 W. 160 poles to a Stake, Northwest corner to said Survey; thence North 46 poles to a Stake, Northeast corner to Robison and Creighton's Survey No. 7263 & 7799; thence West 337 poles to a Stake, Northwest corner to said Survey; thence North 163 poles to a Stake in the line of Bonner's said Survey; thence East 31 poles to the beginning.
