

Beginning at a Stake in the line of said Hoffman's Survey No. 6246, Northwest corner to William Creighton's Survey No. 5670, running East 120 poles to a Stake in the line of Sigismond Stribling's Survey No. 5802 and corner to said Creighton; thence with Stribling's line N. 19 W. 223 poles to a Hickory and Bur Oak, Northwest corner to said Stribling's Survey; thence West 50 poles to two Black Oaks and four White Oaks in the line of said Hoffman's Survey; thence with said line South 210 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for the Representatives of Thomas Ruffin, decd. 200 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5499, on the Spring fork of Treacles creek. Beginning at a Stake in a prairie, Northwesterly corner to James Galloway Jur's Survey No. 6039, running with his line S. 75 E. 160 poles crossing a branch at 40 poles to a Red Oak, Burr Oak and Hickory, Northeasterly corner to said Galloway's Survey; thence N. 15 E. 170 poles to a Stake in the line of John Patterson's Survey No. 5601; thence with his line, N. 35 W. 168 poles crossing the branch at 40 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Westerly corner to said Patterson's Survey; thence S. 21 W. 280 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for John Baird, assee, 200 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5467, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a Black Oak East corner to Philip Roots Thompson's Survey No. 4126, in the line of James Steel's Survey No. 3725, running with Thompson's line N. 42 W. 200 poles to four White Oaks, North corner to said Thompson's Survey; thence N. 48 E. 160 poles to three Ashes, West corner to John Beck's Survey No. 4125; thence with Beck's line, S. 42 E. 200 poles crossing a branch at 50 poles to a bunch of willows in a slush, in said Beck's line and corner to said Steel's Survey; thence with Steel's line N. 48 W. 160 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for John Crawford 131 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 308, on the waters of the Spring fork of Treacles creek. Beginning at a White Oak, 238 poles N. 40 W. from the Northwest corner of James Galloway's, Jur. Survey No. 6030, running N. 50 W. 140 poles to a Black Oak and two Hickories; thence S. 58 W. 94 poles to a White Oak; thence N. 50 W. 30 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 40 W. 52 poles to a forked bur oak and Black Oak; thence N. 50 E. 187 poles to a Hickory; thence N. 44 E. 140 poles, crossing a branch at 70 poles to the beginning.
