



Beginning at two hickories and two black oaks northerly corner to Thomas Christies Survey No. 556, running with Christie's line, S. 35 E. 467 poles to a hickory and black oak, easterly corner to Christie's; thence N. 55 E. 300 poles to a stake; thence N. 35 W. 467 poles to a hickory, black oak and white oak; thence S. 55 W. 300 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for Robert Jones 200 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 1732 on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at two hickories, southwest corner to Joel Grissels Survey No. 540 and in the line of Thomas Sheldon's Survey No. 1238, running with Sheldon's line West 200 poles to an elm near a pond, northwest corner to said Sheldon's Survey; thence North 160 poles to two hickories and an elm; thence East 200 poles to a stake in a prairie, southwest corner to Charles Ballows Survey and northwest corner to Grissels; thence with Grissels line South 160 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for William S. Smith 1000 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 146 on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at two elms, a post white oak and ash, northeast corner to Samuel K. Bradfords survey No. 1310, running with his line West 400 poles crossing a branch at 144 poles to a cherry, two post white oaks and an elm, northwest corner to Bradford; thence North 400 poles to an ash, elm and white oak; thence East 400 poles, crossing a branch at 300 poles to two hickories, and two red oaks; thence South 400 poles to the beginning.
