

Surveyed for Thomas M. Bayly, assee, 760 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5188, on the lower side of Treacles creek. Beginning at two Elms and a Lynn, upper corner on the creek to John Baird's Survey No. 5263, running up the creek with the meanders thereof and binding thereon, N. 49 W. 30, N. 5 E. 164, N. 22 W. 62, N. 5 W. 30, N. 27 W. 46, N. 54 W. 30, N. 37 W. 42, N. 14 W. 40, N. 40 W. 72, N. 14 W. 42, N. 37 W. 56, North 95, N. 18 W. 20, N. 5 W. 38, N. 18 E. 34, N. 25 E. 42, N. 27 W. 120 poles to a Sycamore and Ash, lower corner to Jacob Brown's Survey No. 5298; thence with his line S. 78½ W. 104 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 12 E. 78 poles to three White Oaks; thence S. 4 W. 60 poles to a forked White Oak; thence S. 50 W. 102 poles to three large White Oaks; thence S. 33 E. 444 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 6 E. 326 poles to a White Oak; thence N. 70 E. 140 poles passing said Baird's upper back corner and with his line to the beginning.

Surveyed for George Mathews, 815 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5251, on the waters of Massie's creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a White Oak, Northwest corner to Nathaniel Terry's Survey No. 1241 and Northeast corner Lawrence Traut's No. 1243, running with his line West 400 poles, crossing a branch at 120 poles to a Black Oak, White Oak, Hickory and Cherry tree, Northwest corner to said Traut's Survey; thence North 351 poles to two White Oaks; thence East 400 poles to a Stake; thence South 351 poles to the beginning.
