



Surveyed for James Galloway, jun. and John Baird, assee's. 225 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants viz: Galloway 150 acres on No. 712 and Baird 75 acres on 5230, on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a Black Oak, Northwest corner to Clement Read's Survey No. 1293, running with his line East 126 poles to two Black Oaks; thence N. 39 E. 166 poles to a Hickory in the line of William White's Survey No. 3642; thence with his line N. 35 W. 110 poles to two Hickories and a Black Oak; thence N. 87 W. 60 poles to three White Oaks; thence S. 75 W. 120 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 15 W. 166 poles to a Stake; thence S. 35 E. 30 poles to two Elms and a Black Jack, Northeast corner to William Tompkin's Survey No. 1450; thence East 40 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for James Galloway Jun. and Thomas M. Bayly, assee. 661 acres of land on part of several Military Warrants, viz: Galloway 231 acres, viz: 83 on part of No. 712 and 148 acres



on 5170 and Bayly 430 acres on Warrants No. 5289, 5291, 5292, 5293 and 30 acres on 5294 on the waters of Paint creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a White Oak, Southeast corner to George Mathew's Survey No. 5706 and Northwest corner to Nathaniel Terry's Survey No. 1241, running with Mathew's line, North 264 poles to three Black Oaks; thence East 400


poles to an Elm near a pond, northwest corner to Thomas Sheldon's Survey No. 1238; thence with his line South 264 poles to a Black Oak, Elm and White Oak, Southwest corner to said Sheldon's Survey and Northeast corner to said Terry's Survey; thence with his line West 400 poles, crossing a small branch several times to the beginning.

Surveyed for James Dungan, assee, 25 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5992, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at two Post Oaks, about 70 poles East of James Dungan's house, corner to Survey No. 14749; thence with the line of said Survey, East 40 poles to a Stake; thence N. 4 E. 100 poles to a Stake; thence West 40 poles to a Stake; thence S. 4 W. 100 poles, passing the Northeast corner of said Survey No. 14749 and with the line thereof to the beginning.
