


Surveyed for George Mathews, 204 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5251 on Three Mile Run, a branch of Darby's creek. Beginning at an Elm and Bur Oak, Northeast corner to James Galloway's junr. Survey No. 5744, running East 170 poles to an Elm, Black Oak and Hickory; thence North 24 poles to three White Oaks; thence East 80 poles to a Black Oak and Bur Oak; thence South 110 poles crossing the run at 56 poles to a Stake; thence S. 61 W. 272 poles to three White Oaks; thence North 200 poles passing Galloway's Southeast corner at 40 poles, and with his line crossing the run at 138 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for James Galloway, jr. Assee, 100 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 712, on the lower side of Treacles creek. Beginning at a Stake on the bank of the creek, lower corner on the creek to John Baird's Survey No. 5263, running down the creek with the meanders thereof S. 1 E. 32, S. 34 E. 43, S. 60 E. 50, S. 4 W. 20, S. 62 W. 32, S. 18 W. 48 poles to a Red Oak, Bur Oak and forked Sugar tree; thence S. 80 W. 120 poles to a Bur Oak in the edge of the plains; thence N. 4 E. 190 poles to a Stake in said Baird's line; thence with his line S. 88 E. 80 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Thomas M. Bayly, assee, 574 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5369, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at three Elms, North corner to Joel Stoke's Survey No. 4214, running N. 42 W. 294 poles crossing a branch at 49 poles to three Hickories and a White Oak in the line of said Bayly's Survey No. 5998; thence with his line and course thereof S. 48 W. 262 poles to two White Oaks in the line of George Wallace's Survey No. 4480; thence with his line S. 43 E. 50 poles to a Stake, East corner to said Wallace's Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 47 W. 59 poles to a Stake in said line; thence S. 52 E. 246 poles to three Hickories and a Black Oak, West corner to said Stokes Survey; thence with his line N. 48 E. 320 poles to the beginning.
