


Surveyed for Thomas M. Bayly, assee, 1092-2/3 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5369 on the waters of Treacles creek. Beginning at a Blue Ash and Black Walnut upper corner on the creek to Andrew

Torborne's Survey No. 2985, running North 120 poles to two White Oaks and a Black Oak; thence N. 70 W. 80 poles to a Red Oak, Ash and Elm; thence S. 70 W. 96 poles to a Hickory, Ash and White Oak; thence N. 64 W. 106 poles to a White Oak in the line of Robert Vance's Survey No. 1095; thence with his line and course thereof N. 53 E. 660 poles, crossing several branches to a Stake; thence S. 37 E. 312 poles to three Elms in said Torborne's line; thence with said line S. 53 W. 564 poles, crossing a branch at 44 and one at 350 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for Thomas M. Bayley, assee, 200 acres of land on two Military Warrants, No. 5285 and 5315, on the waters of Treacles creek. Beginning at a Stake in a prairie, Northeasterly corner to said Bayly's

Survey No. 5479, running East 50 poles, crossing a branch at 40 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence S. 68 E. 56 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 71 E. 160 poles to two White Oaks from one root; thence N. 5 W. 120 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence N. 67 W. 160 poles, crossing the branch at 108 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 24 W. 231 poles to the beginning.

6842, 100 poles South of said Worthington's beginning corner and corner to David Bradford's Survey No. 3972; thence with Worthington's line, South 130 poles to a Bur Oak; thence East 124 poles to three Hickories; thence North 130 poles to a Stake; thence West 124 poles to the beginning.
