


Surveyed for the heirs of Buller Clairborne,

 Military Warrant No. 5135, on the  
 waters of Deer creek. Beginning at  
 three Small Ashes, Westerly corner to  
 John Beck's Survey No. 4125, running  
 with his line N. 17 E. 318 poles cross-  
 ing a branch at 134 and one at 154  
 poles to two Black Oaks and a White  
 Oak in said line; thence N. 73 W. 306  
 poles crossing a branch at 280 poles  
 thence S. 17 W. 318 poles to a Red Oak, Elm and White Oak  
 to two White Oaks and a Red Oak; thence  
 N. 73 West 118 poles to three White Oaks;  
 thence S. 48 W. 126 poles, crossing a branch  
 at 50 poles to three White Oaks; thence S. 42 E.  
 356 poles to a White Oak, Black Oak and Ash; thence




North 96 poles crossing a branch at 40 poles to a Stake in a prairie;  
 thence N. 24 E. 68 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence East 50 poles  
 crossing a branch at 47 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence  
 S. 68 E. 56 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root; thence S. 6 W. 285  
 poles to a Stake; thence West 54 poles to three large White Oaks; thence  
 N. 30 W. 134 poles crossing a branch at 110 poles to two small Hickories  
 and a Bur Oak; thence North 40 poles to two Bur Oaks in the line of said  
 Bayly's Survey; thence with said line East 18 poles to the beginning.

Survey; thence with the line of Survey No. 5795, S. 4 E. 50 poles to a  
 stake; thence West 163 poles to the beginning.
