


Surveyed for Richard Apperson and John Woodford, heir, 550 acres of land on part of Two Military Warrants, to-wit: Apperson 225 acres on No. 5134 and Woodford 325 acres on No. 1606, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at Two Red Oaks and a Bur Oak and Ash, corner to Richard Apperson's Survey No. 5433; thence with his line, North 145 poles to a Stake, corner to Guthery & Apperson's Survey No. 6260; thence with their S. 52 E. 340 poles to a Stake, corner to said Survey; thence S. 59 W. 460 poles to two Black Oaks; thence West 45 poles to nine Aspens in the line of Hardin & Gray's Survey No. 280, and corner to John Bryant's Survey No. 6260; thence with his line N. 19 W. 150 poles to two Hickories, corner to said Bryant and in the line of said Survey No. 5433; thence with said line, N. 53 E. 275 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Richard Apperson and the Representatives of George Guthery, 719-1/2 acres of land, on two Military Warrants, Apperson 275 acres on part of No. 5134 and Guthery 444-1/2 acres on No. 5016, on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at a Stake in the line of Richard Apperson's Survey No. 5433, and corner to Robert Mean's Survey No. 5766; thence with Mean's line S. 52 E. 285 poles to a White Oak stump corner to said Mean's; thence with another of his lines S. 24 E. 370 poles to a Stake and two Jack Oaks; thence S. 59 W. 140 poles to a Stake, corner to Apperson and Woodford's Survey No. 6260 of 550 acres; thence N. 52 W. 340 poles to a Stake in the line of Apperson's said Survey No. 5433; thence with his line North 375 poles to the beginning.
