



Surveyed for Allen Latham, assee. 904-1/2 acres of land on part of three Military Warrants, to-wit: 751 acres on No. 5549, 89 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres on No. 6381, and 64 acres on No. 6647, on the waters of Opposom run, of Deer Creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak, Red Oak and Elm, a Northerly corner to Robert Mean's Survey No. 5766; thence S. 70 E. 148 poles to a Stake in the line of Thomas Chilton's Survey No. 5376; thence with said line East 45 poles to a Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence with another line of said Survey, S. 30 E. 42 poles to a Black Oak; thence S. 57 E. 120 poles to a large White Oak, and three small Hickories; thence S. 44 W. 145 poles to a Black Oak, small White Oak and Hickory; thence N. 70 E. 91 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 80 E. 69 poles to Bur Oak and small Jack Oak, Southwest corner to Anthony Singleton's Survey No. 4944; thence binding on said Survey, N. 18 W. 88 poles to a stake in a prairie; thence N. 70 E. 142 poles to two Hickories and small Jack Oak; thence S. 18 E. 102 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a leaning Black Oak; thence S. 70 W. 52 poles to a Stake; thence N. 84 E. 65 poles to a forked White Oak on the Columbus Road in the line of Lewis Booker's Survey No. 1467; thence with his line, N. 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 121 poles to three White Oaks, (dead) Southeasterly corner to John Graham's Survey No. 8420; thence N. 89 W. 182 poles to a Hickory and Black Oak; thence S. 87 W. 114 poles to three Hickories and a White Oak; thence N. 1 E. 286 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory, Northwest corner to Robert Robert's Survey No. 8094; thence S. 84-3/4 W. 120 poles to three Hickories and an Elm, corner to Survey No. 8423; thence N. 80 W. 92 poles to a Black Oak; thence S. 61 W. 29 poles to five Elms, original corner to Survey No. 6285; thence with the line of the same, West 335 poles to two Hickories, a Bur Oak, and Black Oak; thence S. 20 W. 121 poles to three Elms, a Maple and Bur Oak, in the line of Richard Apperson's Survey No. 5433; thence S. 77 E. 167 poles to a Bur Oak, Hickory and Elm, his corner; thence S. 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 54 poles to a double Elm, Bur Oak, Black Oak and Hickory, corner to Mean's said Survey; thence S. 75 E. 211 poles to a Stake, corner to said Survey; thence N. 20 E. 70 poles to the beginning.
