


Surveyed for Elias Langham, assee, 133-1/3 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5740, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at two White Oaks and a Hickory in the line of James Innis's Survey No. 2692, Southeast corner to Uriah Springer's Survey No. 1020; thence with Springer's line N. 70 W. 96 poles to a Stake, S. 66½ W. 1¼ poles from three Hickories marked as a corner; thence S. 20 W. 222 poles, crossing the London road at 60, Turkey run at 90 and a branch at 144 poles to two Hickories; thence S. 70 E. 96 poles to a Stake, 3 poles N. 20 E. from a large White Oak in Innis' line; thence with said line N. 20 E. 222 poles, crossing the run and the road at 130 poles to the beginning.



Beginning at a Stake, Northwest corner to Samuel Smith's Survey No. 4156; thence North 46 poles to a Stake; thence West 337 poles to a Stake; thence South 246 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence East 337 poles to a Bur Oak and Black Oak in the line of Smith's said Survey; thence with said line North 200 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Henry Brush, assee. 300 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5934, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at three Post Oaks in the line of Daniel Brown's Survey No. 6101, Southwest corner to Samuel Baskerville's Survey No. 6023; thence with



Baskerville's lines East 134 poles to a Black Oak, corner to said Survey; thence North 98 poles to two Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence East 45 poles to two Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence North 125 poles to a White Oak and Hickory, Southwest corner to Conrad Kremer's Survey No. 8326; thence with his line East 103 poles to a Stake, 3 poles North of two Bur Oaks; thence South 346 poles to three Hickories in the line of Joseph Harness' Survey No. 5532; thence with his line S. 56 W. 48 poles to a Walnut and White Oak, corner to said Survey; thence N. 43 W. 140 poles to a forked Elm, in the edge of a Prairie, corner to said Survey;

thence West 148 poles to a Hickory, Southeast corner to Brown's said Survey; thence with a line thereof, North 48 poles to the beginning.
