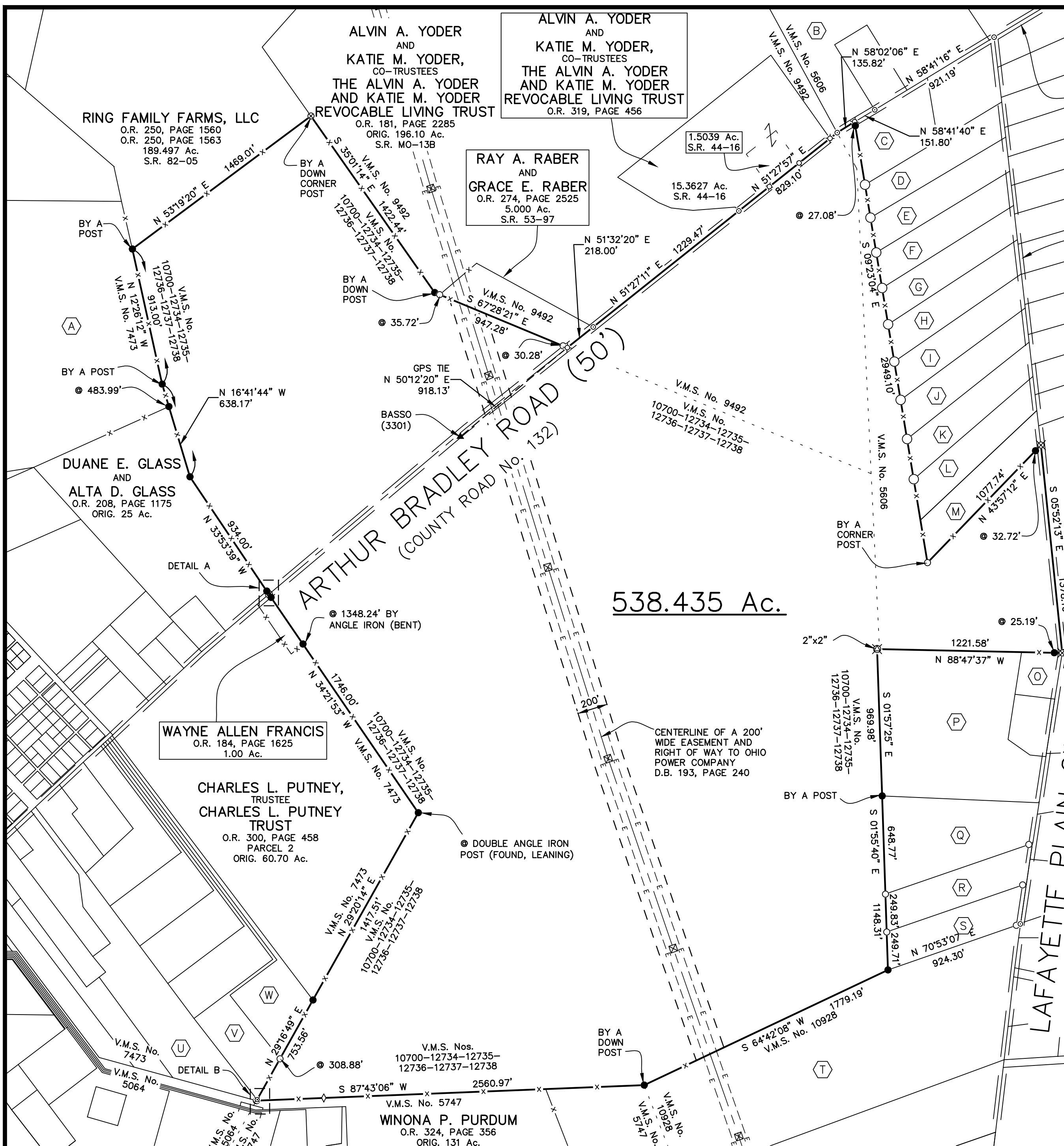

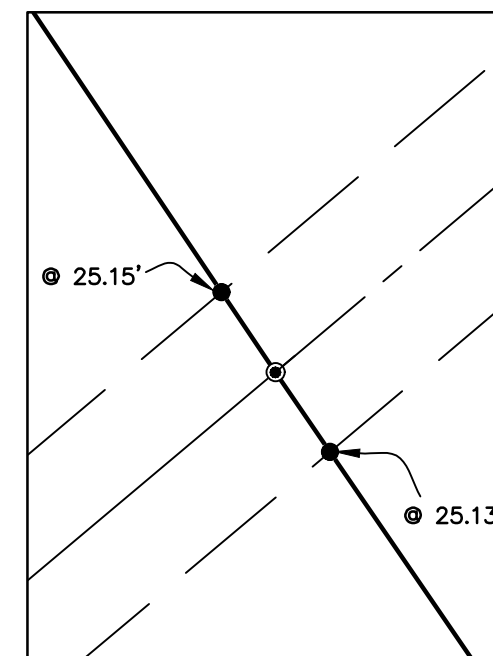

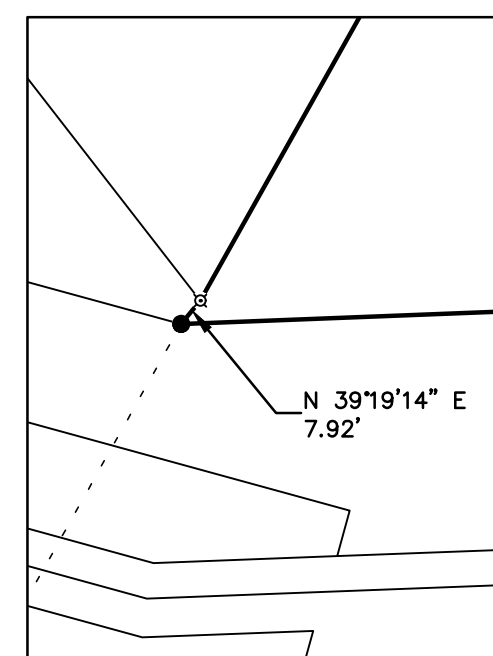

thence with the centerline of Lafayette Plain City Road S 05°52'13" E, a distance of 1378.16 feet to the point of beginning, **containing 538.435 acres of land.**

Subject to a right-of-way and easement for electric transmission line 200 feet in width as recorded in Deed Book 193, Page 240 of the Madison County Recorder's Office.

Subject to all legal easements and rights-of-way of record.

Bearings are based upon the Grid Azimuth (AZ. 189° 12' 32") between National Geodetic Survey CORS Station "OHUN" and McCarty Associates Geodetic Survey Monument "BASSO (3301)" and derived from GPS observations taken February 18, 2019, utilizing the Trimble ODOT CORS VRS (Virtual Reference System).

Land surveyed in February 2019, under the direction of Jason C. McConnaughey, Registered Professional Surveyor No. 8509, the survey plat of which is referred to as Project No. S19-757 on file in the office of McCarty Associates, LLC, Washington C.H., Ohio.
